



B2B – take-back concept - note on the return of old devices

January 2023

According to the EU Directive 2002/96/EC of the European Parliament and the EU Council for old electrical devices (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment - WEEE) and the new version of the EU Directive, 2012/19/EU, there is an obligation to collect old electrical devices, to treat them in accordance to regulations, to dispose them and to finance the procedures.

Electrical and electronic equipment that has become waste is referred to as old device. Owners of old devices must collect them separately from unsorted municipal waste. In particular, old devices do not belong in household waste, but in special collection and return systems.

According to the Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act ElektroG (§7a ElektroG), which applies in Germany, every manufacturer is obliged to create a reasonable possibility for the return of old devices.

Help us to dispose old electronic devices in an environmentally friendly manner. Valuable raw materials can be recovered through professional, environmentally friendly recycling. This protects our environment and existing resources.

We offer you the option of returning your old device to us.

The return is at the expense of the sender. The sender does not pay any costs for the disposal of old devices.
